



CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

1. The licensee shall neither collect blood from any professional donor or paid donor nor shall he prepare blood components from the blood collected from such a donor.
2. The licence and any certificate of renewal in force shall be displayed on the approved premises and the original shall be produced at the request of an inspector appointed under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act 1940.
3. Any change in the technical staff shall be forthwith reported to the Licensing Authority and for Central Licence Approving Authority.
4. The licensee shall inform the Licensing Authority and for Central Licence Approving Authority in writing in the event of any change in the constitution of the firm operating under the licence. Where any change in the constitution of the firm takes place, the current licence shall be deemed to be valid for maximum period of three months from the date on which the change has taken place unless in the meantime, a fresh licence has been taken from the Licensing Authority and / or Central Licence Approving Authority in the name of the firm with the changed constitution.
